## PRESS RELEASE

On 11/15/21 the Patton Township Police Department arrested Mr. Kevin Mullen of State College. Mr. Mullen was being investigated for multiple incidents of sexually assaulting women. The investigation began earlier this year when a victim came forward and told police what happened to her. Five other victims were identified as a result of the investigation and Mr. Mullen was charged for assaults ranging from 2012 to 2021.

Mr. Mullen was charged with the following:

- 4 counts of Rape by Forcible Compulsion--Felony 1
- 5 counts of Sexual Assault--Felony 2
- 5 counts of Indecent Assault--Misdemeanor 2
- 1 count of Criminal Attempt-Rape by Forcible Compulsion--Felony 1
- 1 count of Criminal Attempt-Sexual Assault--Felony 2
- 1 count of Criminal Attempt-Indecent Assault--Misdemeanor 2
- 2 counts of Simple Assault--Misdemeanor 2
- 1 count of Strangulation--Felony 2
- 2 counts of Involuntary Deviate Sexual Intercourse--Felony 1
- 1 count of Aggravated Indecent Assault--Felony 2

This investigation will remain open and active. The Patton Township Police Department believes that there might be other victims who have not yet been identified. Police are asking anyone who might have information related to Mr. Mullen to come forward. Police hope that this press release will reach any other potential victims of Mr. Mullen's and encourage them to speak with our detectives.

Upon his arrest, Mr. Mullen was arraigned on the above charges at MDJ McClain's office. Mr Mullen was committed to the Centre County Correctional facility as he was unable to post his \$750,000 bail.
